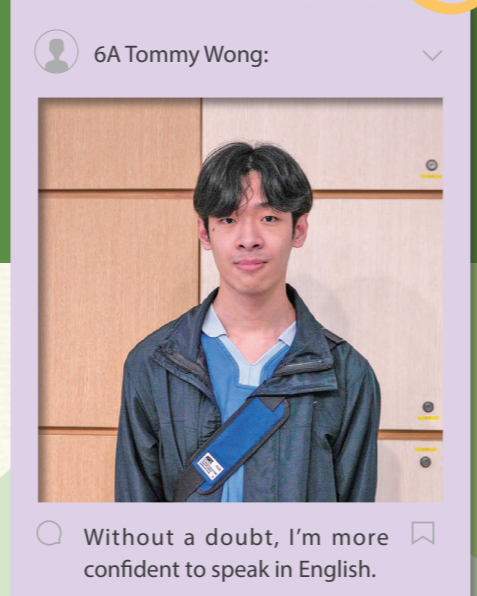

Fun reading class every Tuesday after school

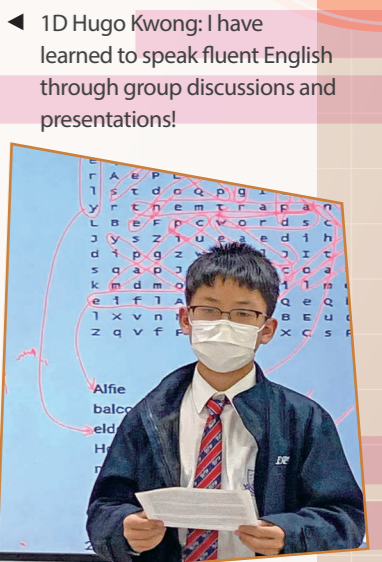

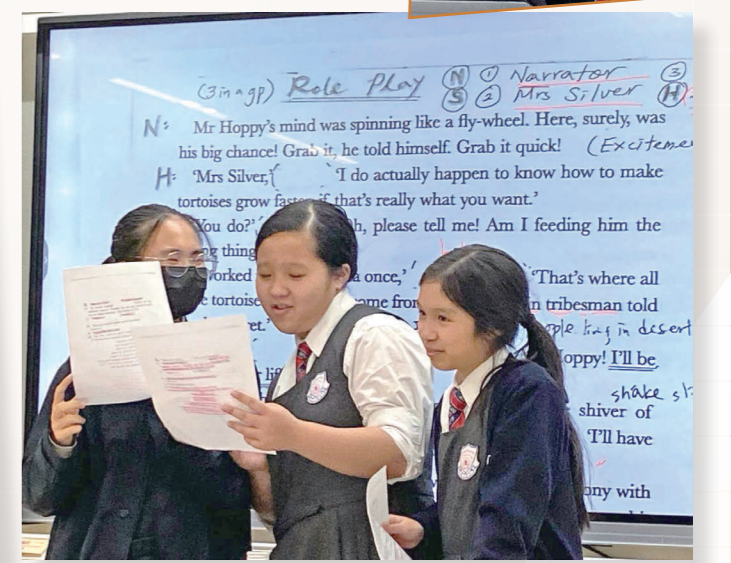
I am grateful for these expressive, inquisitive and fun-loving kids, who demonstrate a love of reading and learning - huge milestones in our lives.
